## **CareFirst Day of Equity and Action Recap**

In the afternoon, associates participated in community service activities with numerous nonprofit partners throughout our region.

This Day of Equity and Action focused on promoting greater empathy, understanding, inclusion, equity and belonging in the workplace and in our communities. The following list shows our high-level community service impacts on October 2:

- Assembled more than 5,000 personal hygiene care kits for individuals experiencing homelessness
- Packed nearly 14,000 infant bundles for families, including 345,000 diapers
- Collectively, associates committed more than 10,000 hours of time with and for over 30 nonprofit organizations
